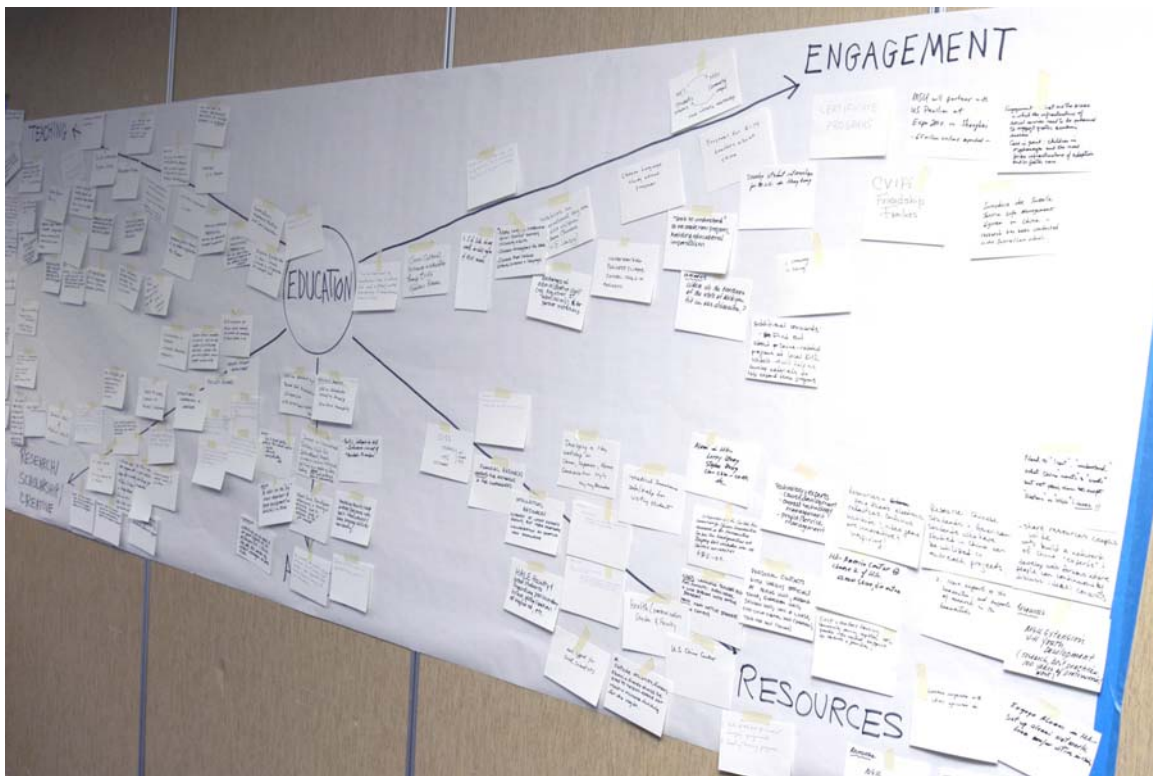


# Global Encounter-China
